EOM-2	Proportion of patients who died who were admitted to hospice for 3 days or more NQF 0215/0216)	Inadequate communication early or throughout the course of treatment makes hospice seen as "giving up" – something to avoid	Strong clinician communication ensures shared decision-making throughout the course of treatment	Online CE courses in communication skills Scripts and prompts on introducing hospice, with cultural considerations	Consulting or collaborative role during treatment also eases the transition to hospice if needed

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EOM-3	Percentage of patients who died from cancer receiving chemotherapy in last 14 days of life (NQF 0210)	Inadequate communication early or throughout the course of treatment makes this scenario more likely	Strong clinician communication ensures shared decision-making throughout the course of treatment	Online CE courses in communication skills	Consulting or collaborative role to support family decision-making
EOM-4a	Oncology: medical and radiation –pain intensity quantified (NQF 0384)	Inadequate pain assessment – perhaps due to uncertainty of pain management options	Skilled assessment of pain and communication with patient/family	Online CE course in pain assessment Pain assessment tools	N/A
EOM-4b	Oncology: medical and radiation –plan of care for pain (NQF 0383)	Insufficient pain management planning – perhaps due to uncertainty of pain management options	Effective and proactive management of pain and symptoms	Online CE courses in pain and symptom management, including in the context of substance use disorder Pain assessment tools	Consulting or collaborative role for intractable pain or complex pain management
